DESCRIPTION

Liquid admixture with fungicidal and algacidal properties for the prevention of and treatment for mildly affected areas of moss and other fungal growths.

- Improves the conservation of treated substrates.
- Treated substrate may be painted after all signs of algae/fungi growth have been removed.
- Suitable with "Historical Buildings" requirements.

BENEFITS

- Treats moss and other fungal growth.
- Helps prevent appearance of new fungi.
- Compatible with Parex finishes.
- Fungicide - algacide protection.
- Solvent free and ready to use.

FIELD OF APPLICATION

- Removal of moss, algae, fungal type organic growth on buildings: gables, facade walls, roofs, terraces, balconies, exterior stairs, pediments, thresholds, window sills etc.
- Exterior landscaping: pavements, walkways, walled enclosures, pools, statues, railings, ponds and tanks not stocked with fish.
- Leisure equipment: tennis courts, caravans.
- Further coats may be applied after water cleaning the surface.
- Does not stain zinc.
- Suitable for use on wood, bricks, slate, concrete, composite materials, shingle, etc.

TECHNICAL CHARACTERISTICS

COMPOSITION

- Density: 1 at 20°C.
- Colour: translucent.
- Product ready for use.
- pH: 7.

PRODUCT PREPARATION

- Shake container well before use.

APPLICATION

Application on substrate with green algae

- Remove large algae deposits with a brush or where appropriate by scraping.
- Apply 251 LANKO NET VERT with a brush, roller, sponge or low pressure spray directly onto the area to be treated. Ensure the whole area is saturated.
- For enhanced efficiency use a roller.
- Allow at least 12 hours in dry weather for treatment to take effect.
- Green algae and other deposits will gradually dry out and blacken.

- Once treatment has taken full effect, clean the surface to remove the deposits with a brush or pressure washer - ensure the brush and pressure setting does not damage the substrate.
- Renew treatment if necessary on heavily affected areas.

Preventative treatment – Application on clean and sound substrates

- Treat substrate in the spring or autumn to avoid the proliferation of algae or lichens which may cause damage.
- Apply 251 LANKO NET VERT with a brush, roller, sponge or low pressure spray directly onto the area to be treated. Ensure whole area is saturated.
- Do not rinse.
- Use our complementary protective products to prolong treatment:
 - 238 LANKO RESIST HYDRO
 - 239 LANKO RESIST SOL MAT
 - 240 LANKO RESIST EFFET MOUILLÉ

SPRAY APPLICATION RECOMMENDATIONS

- Use a perfectly clean, low pressure sprayer (<3 bars, garden type).
- Use a protective visor and wear protective clothing.
- Protect adjacent areas against over spray.
- Application should be carried out in dry conditions.
- Do not use spray application in windy conditions.

CONSUMPTION

Coverage is provided as guidance only, excludes wastage and will vary subject to substrate conditions
From 5 to 10m² per litre.

PRECAUTIONS

- Treat in dry weather.
- Protect from rain.
- Do not apply to frozen or thawing substrates.
- Leave to act, do not rinse immediately after application.
- Protect vegetation around areas being treated.
- Do not apply to materials which will be in contact with foodstuffs.
- Preliminary testing is recommended, particularly for lichens.

- 5 litre container.
- 20 litre container.

STORAGE AND SHELF LIFE

18 months from date of manufacture if stored in unopened original packing in frost-free conditions away from sources of heat and high temperatures.

WARRANTY

Manufacturer's 10 year product indemnity including design when a Parex specification is issued. Subject to conditions.
